This show is a qualifier for the BSPS heritage champs & Binks family champions of champions.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliated No:24-136. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS(UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS(UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner & Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current Showing Member and have a valid Qualifier Card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 15-17th August 2024. The following classes are CHAPS(UK) Qualifiers, 69-72. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification please refer to the CHAPS(UK) Members Handbook or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only Skewbald's/Piebald's may compete in these classes.

Rules & Conditions: All exhibitors entering the show will have read the following and agree to follow while attending the show.

- **1** Judges: The judge's decision is final. The Committee reserve the right to substitute any judge in the unlikely event of a cancelation. The judge may withhold any prize where there is evident want of merit, where there is only one entry shown in a class, the judge may award first, second, third or fourth prize according to merit of entry.
- 2 Cancellation of classes Any class with insufficient entries may be amalgamated with a class of same type.
- 3 Objections Objections shall be made in writing with the objectors full name and address within one hour of the event concerned. This must be lodged with the secretary at the secretary office together with the fee of £25.00 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained, if the objection is not sustained then the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the West Yorkshire wpca.
- **4** Entry Fees We very much regret that entry fees cannot be returned, the only exception would be with a veterinary certificate stating that the horse or pony is unfit for competition, or if the show has to be cancelled for any unforeseen circumstances.
- **5** Rules in General All exhibitors, grooms and all other persons admitted to the showground shall subject to the rules and regulations of the show. The West Yorkshire wpca shows will not be responsible in anyway for any loss, damage or injury to animals, people or their property from any cause or circumstances whatso ever. Acceptance of the rules and regulations of the WYWPCA shall be a condition of entry.
- **6** Entries All Welsh ponies must be registered with the WPCS and registration number entered on the entry form. Registration numbers of Sire and Dam must be included on entry form. ALL INCORRECT ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED
- **7** WPCS Medals Medals will be awarded to the champion or reserve of each of the section of the stud book, as per the regulations governing medals awarded.
- **8** Parking All show attendees will adhere to the instructions of the parking attendants, failing to comply with this will result in being asked to leave the show.
- 9 Stabling Anyone interested or requiring stabling should contact the show secretary as soon as possible.
- **10** Medical Cover All exhibitors are asked to include an additional £2 with their entry to cover the cost of 1st aid attendee.
- **11** Stallions Any colt/stallion 2yrs & above must be adequately bitted, stallions attending must hold a stallion licence. Any small breed stallion must not be ridden by anyone aged under 12yr, and large breed stallion must not be ridden by anyone under age 14yr.

This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony & Cob Society. Affiliation No AF00188, Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging & Showing Handbook which can be found on the society website www.wpcs.uk.com or request from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.
